

Mikhail Grigorievich, 86, suffers from lung and kidney ailments. He will now be able to afford medications and in-patient care.



Bronislava Yakovlevna, 78, suffers from severe glaucoma, and cataracts. She can now afford the medications that will prevent her from becoming completely blind.



Maya Izrailevna, age 82, receives her first gift of aid from The Survivor Mitzvah Project. Her government pension is only \$45/month; not enough for food, heat or medications. Now she can afford these life-saving necessities.

Yulia Stepanovna was just a baby at war's end. Survivors who were young children during the Holocaust were seriously affected because they grew up malnourished, lacking enough milk, protein and basic nutrition. As adults they have major health issues.

While most of the survivors we help are in their 80s and 90s, with some even 100 years old, Yulia is 73. She looks far older than her years because she has been denied healthcare her entire life. She will use the money for food and medications.
